Inspire Workshops

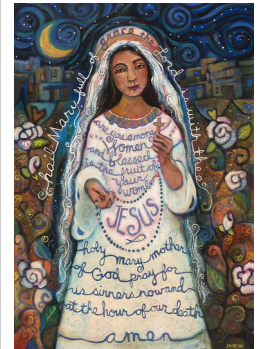

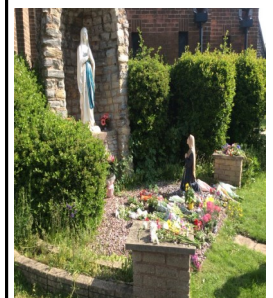
