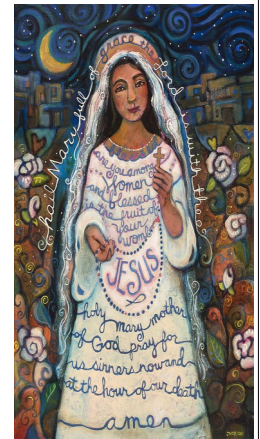
Y6 Transition Visits

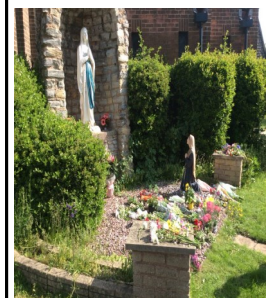
