Welcome to Mass. Before Mass, talk to God. During mass, Listen to God. After mass, Talk to each other. Notices in italics - off-site. Symbol of the cross: dice (John 19.24)

Ent.Antiphon: Hear us, O Lord, have mercy upon us: for we have sinned against thee. Rejoice, Jerusalem and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning and be satisfied with her consoling breast.

Psalm: Taste and see that the Lord is good.

Gospel acclamation: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, word of the Father, Son of God. I will leave this place and go to my father and say: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you.'
