Sacramental Programme 2021. Another reminder that school is about to embark on its ambitious programme of First Holy Communion and Confirmation in May, June and July. Father Simon and I must insist that only two adults attend the masses to comply with the current restrictions. This will remain the case for all of the masses between now and July. A footnote to this is that if any family wants to take the day away from school for a special meal/celebration after mass then please feel free to do so. All I ask is that you let Mr Barton or I know what your plans are.



Confirmation will be over two masses 5:00pm and 7:00pm on June 9th, again Father Simon and I must insist on only two parents attend to ensure we comply with current restrictions. <u>**Coronavirus.**</u> All the signals continue to look promising as society heads further along the roadmap of returning to something like normal. We have however been informed that one of our families is having to self-isolate due to a positive case in their household. Please let's stay vigilant, follow the rules and get your vaccine when you asked to attend. Staff are continuing to test themselves twice a week and will do so for the foreseeable future. I hope that there will be no more interruption and we can all get through to July without any children missing any more school.

<u>Summer Term.</u> School will close for the Whit holiday on Friday May 28th, reopening on Monday June 7th. The school year ends at 1:00pm on Friday July 16th. A reminder that school will be closed on Friday June 25th for teacher training.
