Lord Jesus Christ, only begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us, you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer, you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

First reading: Acts 2.1-11
They were all filled with the Holy Spirit.

Psalm response: *Send forth your Spirit O Lord and renew the face of the earth*

Second reading: 1 Corinthians 12.3-7, 12-13. *In the one Spirit we were all baptised.*

Gospel acclamation: *Alleluia, alleluia. Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful, and kindle in them the fire of your love.*

Gospel: John 20.19-23
Jesus said to the Apostles, 'receive the Holy Spirit'.

Apostles Creed I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only son, Our Lord, *who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.* I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

Offertory: Holy Spirit, come confirm us, in the truth that Christ makes known. We have faith and understanding through your helping gifts alone.

2. Holy Spirit, come console us; come as Advocate to plead. Loving Spirit from the Father, grant in Christ the help we need.

3. Holy Spirit, come renew us; come yourself to make us live: Holy through Your loving Presence Holy through the gifts You give.

4. Holy Spirit, come possess us, You the love of Three in One. Holy Spirit of the Father, Holy Spirit of the Son.

Pray Brethren that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the almighty Father.

All: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.

Sanctus: Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

The Mystery of faith. All: We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection, until you come again.

Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those who are called to his supper of the Lamb. All: **Lord I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.**

Final hymn:

Come down, O love divine, seek thou this soul of mine,
And visit it with thine own ardour glowing.
O Comforter, draw near, within my heart appear,
And kindle it, Thy holy flame bestowing.

O let it freely burn, til earthly passions turn
