\* **Contactless Giving** If the last few months has taught us anything, it's that we have made a massive move to becoming a cashless society with some 70% of everyday transactions now being made via card. 50% of British people have never written a cheque. With the decline of high street banks and cashpoints cash is starting to be hard to use.

Last year the diocese spent over £77k in bank charges and when your parish pays cash into the bank it costs 30p per £100 banked, every paying-in slip costs 40p and every cheque paid in costs 20p.
