### **Homily**

**Nicene Creed** I believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things, visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made.

\* Hong Kong – In order to provide sanctuary to those needing to leave Hong Kong, The UK Home Office has forecast that between 123,000 and 153,000 dependents will apply in this first year for a special visa. There are, in total, over 350,000 Hong Kong citizens who hold BNO Passports and a further 2.5 million who are eligible for one. The Bishops' Conference, while welcoming the Government's approach to Hong Kong immigrants, has responded to the Home Secretary's announcement of what was described as "*the most significant of our asylum system in decades,*" echoing Pope Francis' call

for us to welcome, promote, protect and integrate refugees. Bishop Paul McAleenan, the lead Bishop for Migrants and Refugees said: *“the assistance that we provide to our sisters and brothers fleeing war, poverty, or persecution is a fundamental test of our society”*. “Restore” ([www.restore-uk.org](http://www.restore-uk.org)) is a project of Birmingham Churches Together, which supports Refugees and those seeking Sanctuary.
