

Subject:	We are learning about:
Religious Education	Reconciliation - exploring our choices, good and bad, the consequences of sin and Christ's teaching on forgiveness. Focus on Bible stories with the theme of forgiveness: Zacchaeus and the Prodigal Son. Preparing for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Advent- looking at the stories of the Visitation and the Annunciation. Develop their understanding of Advent as a time of preparation for Christmas.
Numeracy	Place value, Operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division - Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables they know. Solve and investigate problems, including missing number problems, and word problems involving the 4 operations.
Literacy	Fiction - Script writing: as we will be converting a chapter from Roald Dahl's BFG into a script. Non - fiction: Writing instructions related to the text the BFG of how to catch a dream. Spelling Y3/4 common exception words., Punctuation- use of capital letters and full stops, commas, exclamation marks and question marks, inverted commas, commas. Handwriting - developing joined, fluent and consistent style, and Grammar- using conjunctions. Fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, word families, use of paragraphs.
Science	Rocks and Soils- compare and group together rocks. Look at fossils and how they are formed and recognise soil is made from rocks and organic matter. Label and describe the hardness of the rocks.
Computing	Online safety - Focus on online Relationships QR Codes - what they are, how to create them and how to link them to a sound file.
Art	Use colour mixing strategies to create Stonehenge artwork. Sketch images relating to Prehistory. Create their own Cave Art.
D&T	Ask, explore, design, make and evaluate a game using static electricity.
Geography	Name and locate different monuments from Prehistory. Identify good places to build Iron Age hillforts
History	Sequence and explain how Britain changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. Explore different sources and can explain why this time period is presented in different ways. Explore different theories about the building of Stonehenge. Understand how the Bronze age was different to the Stone Age. Imagine what life might have been like in an Iron Age Hillfort.
Music	Use their voice and instrument with increasing accuracy. Recall some sounds heard in pieces of music. Identify some instruments that may have originated in the prehistoric era.
PE	Gymnastics: Plan and perform a range of movements in sequences with a partner and a small group. Practise and develop flexibility, agility and control. Explore a range of balances and shapes using different body parts on different levels. Use of range of apparatus.
Spanish	Learn vocabulary related to classroom objects including adjectives in the masculine and feminine forms. Expressing opinions and ask simple questions.
