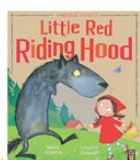

Activities you can do at home

Sing songs and nursery rhymes:

Count small groups of objects and look out for the numbers 1 to 5.
Look out for shapes. Can you see a square, rectangle, circle or triangle?
